Pro's Prose



Trouble shots might be a hot topic of conversation after the round, but they are less popular at the practice range. There are several reasons why we don't practice trouble shots. First of all, we never expect to have to play a trouble shot. And there are not many practice areas set up to work on these types of shots. Besides, trouble shots are not the most glamorous shots to practice. Imagine yourself hitting a large basket of practice balls from all different lies and slopes around the chipping green.

Hitting a chip shot from a side hill/down hill lie. **Understand:** Don't try to hit this shot high. The slope of the ground has already determined that this shot must be hit low.

Key: The important key is to make solid contact. You're going to use a basic chipping technique with one adjustment: angle your shoulders with the slope. This will help you swing with the slope. On a downhill chip, you will make a higher back swing and a lower follow through. Good Luck!
